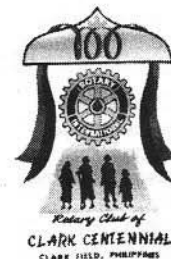

### Meeting Minutes – November 27, 2007

**SECRETARY'S REPORT:** Mark Smith is in the States and an hour after he left his father died. He will be coming home on Friday. Sec. Rey also informed everyone the 75th birthday of our late hero Ninoy Aquino. One of his dream was someday we can give the country a better and equitable distribution of opportunities, one of the inspiration why help the Bahay Bata.

PP Ron and foundation President Joey, discussed the possibility of putting together or subsidizing a Rotarian who have done their job well. They thought of rewarding the Rotarian who has done their job excellently so, we'll be nominating 3 Rotarians in sponsoring the Paul Harris fellow. That way, the \$3,000 we put in the matching grant goes to the rotary foundation as a Paul Harris Fellow. They suggested that every year at the minimum Paul Harris Fellow sponsored by the club as a reward for the outstanding service for the year and Treas. Mark said that it is a noble idea. So, the club will have to form a committee of 3 to study this further.

**FOUNDATION PRESIDENT REPORT:** Last week, Friday, the owner of the Enclave, Mr. Lee, accompanied by Sony Lopez, went to the center. We gave him a tour in the center and he was impressed on what the Rotarians are doing in the center. We checked together with PP Bill Wright the baseball field. PP Bill explained what the Rotarians are doing in the Baseball field. He said that the panels cost \$500 each and they are for five years. Mr. Lee said that they go to the opening of the Enclave and he'll get the \$4,000. The next day, as soon as PP Bill Wright arrives, he gave the \$4000 and said that that is just the beginning and he said that he will be supporting the center more.

**PRESIDENT VICTOR'S TIME:** The Strongsville grant is almost completed to the point that President Victor will be sending it on Friday so that they can have it on the December 30 meeting to approve.

**NOMINATION:** Tatang Bruce is the COMELEC chair and he said put the nomination as is President Elect. George Watson, VP: Erling Rune, Sec: Marcus Fahy, Treas. Mark Smith, Sgt at Arms: John McCully, Directors: Howard ketley, Bob Hartzell, Bill Campbell and Brian Tan.

**3H GRANT REPORT BY VP JOEL DUNGCA:** VP Joel Dungca searched the web about the 3H grant. He said that 3H grant is about Hunger, humanitarian and health. The philosophy of the 3H grant talks about 'give them fish and they eat for a day, teach them how to fish and they eat for a lifetime'. The program requirements are improving health, irrigate hunger, enhance human and social development, advance international understanding, goodwill and peace \* long term self-well benefits, interactive approach and the rotary must have a previous matching grant with other partnership in a span of five years. The grant will be 2-4 years. The month of the grant runs in a minimum of \$100,000-\$300,000 and a minimum of 10% of that is the contribution of the coach. Other requirements will be, it should be community based, and Rotarians should support and participate on the grant with the beneficiary, sustainability that includes training on the assigned community and community participation.

The rotary club and the Rotarian should work with the community to decide and implement the project. Participate in the project activities based in the

government officials, visit project sites, control project funds. These are the five basic tasks of the Rotary club as well as the Rotarians. The application should be submitted on the 31st of March 2008. The application deadline is August 1 and the Final deadline for the application completion is on Nov. 1 and the grant will select who will receive the acceptance will be on December. Sec. Rey suggested documenting what the club has been doing.

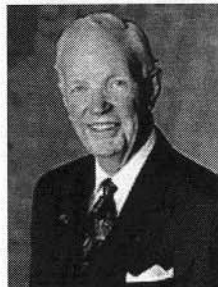
