Rotary Club of Clark Centennial Meeting Minutes 28 October 2008

President Joel Dungca brought the meeting to order at 12:30P.M.. He asked George Watson to report on the requirements and costs for putting together a baseball tournament. Cost for equipment for each team is roughly P35,000 and the equipment usually lasts for two years. The cost of putting on a game is about P7,500 which includes food and drinks. Field maintenance costs about P50,000 per year and those costs up to this point have been shouldered by George and Bill Wright. Charles Hoffman suggested that we solicit sponsors from the various American and Australian Veterans Organizations in town.

Derek Hewett reported on the progress of the Christmas at Christmas Fund Raiser, he stated that we need to identify at least five main prizes for donation to be used as the main attraction for the raffle. He challenged the club to set the goals high this year and he set a goal of P1,000,000 as our target. He asked the help of all club members in coordinating this years event.

PP Victor Torrez discussed the Bahay Bata United Nations Day Celebration and he stated that it was an outstanding event that obviously required detailed preparation from the students and the teachers. AB-CBN was in attendance and interviewed Carl Chiulli as well as Drs. Froilan Canlas and Brian Tan the event will be shown on November 15th on Channel 42, the time of the broadcast will be announced later. AB-CBN also inquired about how they could assist in fund raising for the center. Victor also gave an update on the purchase of computers for the school. He also asked that more members try to spend time at the center.

PP Bruce McTavish announced that there were four new Lifetime Foundation Members and stated that this is another easy way of raising funds, the new Lifetime members are: PP Bruce McTavish, Carmen McTavish, President Joel Dungca and PP Augie Evangelista. The cost of a Lifetime Membership is P10,000 and he encouraged more members to purchase them.

President Joel Dungca stated that we needed to form committees to coordinate the Annual Christmas Party at Bahay Bata. George Watson was appointed as the coordinator of this years event. He also stated that it was time to coordinate the annual visit to Don Bosco and that he would contact Father Rocky and make arrangements.

Charles Hoffman announced that Dr. Deguzman volunteered himself and two nurses to assist with our medical mission.

Derek Hewett was inducted as a member of RCCC. Jimmy Dale levied fines for those members who had not yet paid dues and stated that weekly fines would continue until dues were remitted. RTN John McCully won the raffle and the meeting was adjourned at 2:00P.M.
