He also stated that he would like to see our club achieve 100% status as Paul Harris Fellows and he pledged \$500 to assist any Rotarian who wished to be a Paul Harris Fellow. Ron Nethercutt discussed different options of receiving award recognition for the club.

PP Victor Torres announced that our school was formally approved by the Philippine Department of Education and that House parent Adrian will need to be replaced due to a pending immigration to Canada. He also announced that Grant money in the amount of P155,000 was in the bank. Carl Chuili recommended that Foundation meetings be held more frequently so that we could analyze problems and recommend methods to improve the school.
