## Rotary Club of Clark Centennial Meeting Minutes 16 December 2008

President Joel Dungca brought the meeting to order at 12:30. Secretary Bob Hartzell gave the Secretary's report. Rtn. Bill Campbell was the Day Chairman.

President Joel spoke about the success of the Christmas party at Bahay Bata on 12 December. George Watson was recognized for organizing the event. George thanked all who assisted in making this party one of the best ever. Special thanks was given to the teachers at the center who spent many hours choreographing and leading the students to make outstanding presentations. Kudos were extended to Jimmy "D" for another outstanding job as Santa Claus.

President Joel explained that we must learn to be more proactive in our planning for future events. We had become used to Mark Smith taking care of many of the details that we seem to take for granted. The club entertained more than 300 children at this year's event. Gifts and food baskets were funded by utilizing P25,000 from the club treasury and another P25,000 from the Foundation Fund. Jimmy Dale suggested that we set up budgets in advance so that we could systematically use club funds without the fear of misappropriation or running out of money.

Christmas at Christmas Raffle Tickets are still available for sale, all club members are urged to do their best to sell as many as possible. PP Bruce McTavish suggested that each member should sell at least P5,000 worth of tickets but it was decided that it was too close to the event to force such an issue.

The January 6<sup>th</sup> meeting will be held at the Board Room (formerly Four Seasons) located on Clark. This will be a test to see if the club wants to move our weekly meetings to that location. The annual trip to Don Bosco is scheduled for January 15<sup>th</sup>.
